Earlier Coverage of COVID- 19 Testing at No Cost- Sharing	<ul> <li>Authorizing Language:</li> <li>Amends the requirement that health plans provide free coverage of COVID-19 testing to include tests provided since the beginning of the public health emergency.</li> </ul>	None	
Coverage of COVID-19 Treatment at No Cost- Sharing	<ul> <li>Authorizing Language:</li> <li>Requires all plans to cover treatment for COVID- 19 at no cost-sharing.</li> </ul>	None	
Prescription Drug Refill Notifications During Emergencies	<ul> <li>Authorizing Language:</li> <li>Requires plans to notify consumers of advance prescription drug refill options during emergency periods.</li> </ul>	None	

Subsidies for COBRA and Furloughed Workers	<ul> <li>Authorizing Language:</li> <li>Provides subsidies to allow workers to maintain their employer-sponsored coverage if they become eligible for COBRA or are subject to a temporary furlough.</li> </ul>	None		
Improvements to COBRA Notices	<ul> <li>Authorizing Language:</li> <li>Improves COBRA notices provided to workers who lose employer-sponsored coverage by including information about ACA options.</li> </ul>	None

Emergency Relief for School Meal and Child and Adult Care Food Programs	<ul> <li>Authorizing Language:</li> <li>Provides emergency relief to help school meal and child and adult care food programs, which are in dire need of financial assistance, to continue serving children and families.</li> </ul>	None		
Pandemic EBT	<ul> <li>Authorizing Language:</li> <li>Extends the Pandemic EBT (P-EBT) program through the summer and until schools reopen, and expands the program to include children who would be receiving meals at child care except for COVID-19 related closures.</li> </ul>	None		
Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program	<ul> <li>Authorizing Language:</li> <li>Provides schools increased flexibility to provide children in low-income communities with fresh fruit and vegetable snacks through the Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program.</li> </ul>	None

Women, Infants, and Children (WIC)	• Nearly triples the value of the WIC Cash Value Voucher (CVV) for women and children through the end of fiscal year 2020.	
	<ul> <li>Appropriations:</li> <li>\$1.1 billion for WIC to ensure funding is sufficient to cover any increased participation in the program, and to fund the increased CVV benefit.</li> </ul>	
Child Nutrition Waiver Transparency	<ul> <li>Authorizing Language:</li> <li>Requires the Secretary of Agriculture to make publicly available all child nutrition waiver applications, approvals, and denials pursuant to the Families First Coronavirus Response Act in a timely manner.</li> </ul>	None
Developmental Disabilities Act	<ul> <li>Appropriations:</li> <li>\$5 million for Assistive Technology Act Programs.</li> <li>\$5 million for the purchase of equipment to enable interpreters to provide services to the deaf community remotely.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Appropriations:</li> <li>\$10,000,000 to support protection and advocacy systems.</li> </ul>
