

**AMENDMENT OFFERED BY MS. BONAMICI OF
OREGON
TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A
SUBSTITUTE
To H. R. 4334**

Page 7, line 10, insert “and prevention” after “Control”.

Page 7, line 10, insert “Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services,” after “National Institute on Aging,”.

At the end of title I, add the following (and make such technical and conforming changes as may be appropriate):

**1 SEC. 123. NATIONAL RESOURCE CENTER FOR WOMEN AND
2 RETIREMENT.**

3 Section 202 of the Older Americans Act of 1965 (42
4 U.S.C. 3012), as amended by section 116, is amended by
5 adding at the end the following:

6 “(i)(1) The Assistant Secretary shall, directly or by
7 grant or contract, operate the National Resource Center
8 for Women and Retirement (in this subsection referred to
9 as the ‘Center’).

10 “(2) The Center shall—

1 “(A) provide basic financial management, re-
2 tirement planning, and other educational tools that
3 promote financial wellness and help to identify and
4 prevent fraud and elder exploitation, and integrate
5 these with information on health and long-term care;

6 “(B) annually disseminate a summary of out-
7 reach provided, including work to provide user-
8 friendly consumer information and public education
9 materials;

10 “(C) develop targeted outreach strategies;

11 “(D) provide technical assistance to State agen-
12 cies and to other public and nonprofit private agen-
13 cies and organizations; and

14 “(E) develop partnerships and collaborations to
15 address program objectives.”.

16 **SEC. 124. DEFINITION.**

17 Section 102 of the Older Americans Act of 1965 (42
18 U.S.C. 3002) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
19 lowing:

20 “(55) The term ‘person-centered, trauma-in-
21 formed’ when used with respect to services means
22 services provided through an aging program that—

23 “(A) use a holistic approach to providing
24 services;

1 “(B) promote the dignity, strength and
2 empowerment of victims of trauma; and

3 “(C) incorporate research-based practices
4 based on knowledge about the role of trauma in
5 trauma victims’ lives.”.

6 **SEC. 125. REVIEW OF REPORTS.**

7 Sec. 308(b) of the Older Americans Act of 1965 (42
8 U.S.C. 30299(b)) is amended by inserting at the end the
9 following:

10 “(8) The Assistant Secretary shall review the
11 reports submitted under section 307(a)(31), and in-
12 clude in the report required by section 207(a), ag-
13 gregated data, including the effectiveness and out-
14 reach efforts included in 307(a)(31), on services that
15 are needed by older individuals whose needs are the
16 focus of all centers funded under title IV. This re-
17 quirement applies to all centers funded on the day
18 before the date of enactment of the Dignity in Aging
19 Act of 2019.”.

20 **SEC. 126. AREA PLANS.**

21 Section 306(a) of the Older Americans Act of 1965
22 (42 U.S.C. 3026(a)) is amended in subparagraph
23 (B)(i)(VII) by inserting “, specifically including survivors
24 of the Holocaust” after “placement”.

Page 10, strike lines 4 through 14, and insert the following:

1 “(18) provide assurances that the area agency
2 on aging will collect data to determine the services
3 that are needed by older individuals whose needs are
4 the focus of all centers funded under title IV and the
5 effectiveness of the programs, policies, and services
6 provided by such area agency on aging in assisting
7 these individuals. Each agency plan shall provide as-
8 surances that the area agency on aging will use out-
9 reach efforts that will identify individuals eligible for
10 assistance under this Act, with special emphasis on
11 those individuals whose needs are the focus of all
12 centers established under title IV. This requirement
13 applies to all centers funded on the day before the
14 date of enactment of the Dignity in Aging Act of
15 2019.”.

Beginning on page 18, strike line 18 and all that follows through line 3 on page 11, and insert the following:

16 “(31) The State shall prepare and submit to
17 the Assistant Secretary annual reports on the data
18 collected to determine the services that are needed
19 by older individuals whose needs are the focus of all

1 centers funded under Title IV and the effectiveness
2 of the programs, policies, and services provided by
3 area agencies on aging in assisting these individuals.
4 The reports shall describe any outreach efforts and
5 other activities described in Sec. 306(a)(18). This
6 requirement applies to all centers funded on the day
7 before the date of enactment of the Dignity in Aging
8 Act of 2019.”.
