Washington, DC (February 5, 2013) – The Consortium for School Networking (CoSN) today issued the following statement on the *Transforming Education Through Technology Act*, which was introduced by U.S. Representative George Miller (CA), Ranking Democrat on the U.S. House Education & the Workforce Committee.
