1. SUBJECT: FIELD ACTIVITIES JURISDICTIONAL BOUNDARIES
2. PURPOSE: This Order announces the jurisdictional boundaries of EEOC field activities as approved by the Commission.
3. EFFECTIVE DATE: January 18, 2006
4. ORIGINATOR: Chief Operating Officer, Office of the Chair
5. RESPONSIBILITIES:
 - a. The Commission shall approve the establishment of and changes to jurisdictional boundaries of any EEOC field activity. No jurisdictional boundaries can be established or changed, even temporarily, without Commission approval.
 - b. Commissioners, the General Counsel or the Office of Field Programs Director will recommend to the Commission proposed changes to jurisdictional boundaries when it is determined that it is in the best interest of the Commission to make such changes.
 - c. The Chief Operating Officer is responsible for the development, publication and distribution of appendices to this Order which implements Commission-approved jurisdictional boundaries.
6. FIELD ACTIVITIES JURISDICTIONAL BOUNDARIES:
 - a. By affirmative vote on July 8, 2005 and January 18, 2006, the Commission approved the establishment of field activities jurisdictional boundaries as listed in Appendix A to this Order.
